

Video Snaps	<p>Video snaps allows you to put a series of youtube videos in one feed. You simply type in the keywords or youtube url in the search box, crop the start/end points of the video and add as many videos as you want. Countdown	<p>This activity allows you create visual slideshows. You add the number of items you want. Items can include pictures, links or video links. Swiper	<p>This activity allows users to vote yay or nay on a list of items by swiping right or left. Items are pictures and text.
